

# You Picked Up Your Plants! Now What?

**If you have bareroot plants:**

- 1. Keep roots and plugs wrapped, moist, and cool until you're ready to plant.**
- 2. Get your plants in the ground ASAP (within a few days).**

**Or...**

**Pot plants if you can't plant them right away for long-term storage.**

**What is a bareroot plant?**

**A bareroot plant has no soil on the exposed roots. The roots are susceptible to drying out and killing the plant. It is important to not expose them to air and conditions that will dry them out.**
